


The Young Explorers Club is an exclusive club where members get the opportunity to engage and take part in outdoor activities and learn from experts in their fields.

- Camps are hosted in Switzerland managed by Young Explorers Club.

- > 3 camps/year open to non members with priority to YEC Members

- Membership Grants: Per year 4 club memberships will be offered to 4 applicants as a grant financed by the YEC Official partners.
